
Furry Purse



Cut one piece of fur - $11^{\circ} \times 26^{\circ}$ - this will be the purse.

For the purse handle, cut a piece of fur 2" by the desired length of the handle. (Our handle was 2" x 40".)

Fold each of the purse's 11" edges $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the wrong side and stitch. These turned edges will be the opening for the bag.

Fold the purse fabric in half to measure $11^{\circ} \times 12$. Be sure the top edges are even.

Trim the Dolly fabric 1/2" beyond the stitched border. Turn the edges 1/4" to the back of the fabric and press.

Position the Dolly design in the center of the purse's side. Pin in place. (Be careful you do not pin the two layers of fur together.)

Unfold the purse fabric and stitch the Dolly design to the purse.

Sew the side seams of the purse using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Turn the purse right side out.

Sew the purse handles to the inner side edges of the purse.
